"Working with a judge gave me insight into what effective advocacy looks like, while studying overseas gave me a global outlook. And working as a Crown Prosecutor built up my in-court advocacy experience, so I've been able to develop my skills in lots of different areas."

Since joining CLM, Aimee has quickly found her footing in a team environment she describes as both supportive and challenging. "All of the people here are super friendly and supportive. They're interested in you as a person as well as you producing good quality work. You feel like you've got real wrap-around support and the partners and seniors are so willing to help you.
